COMPETITION RULES

1. Any person wishing to fish the ALL SPECIES Competition must complete an entry form and submit this together with their entry fee for themselves and their crew to Annatjie at the OPBC office. You will then receive a receipt which must be handed in at weigh-in time.
2. Please submit your entry form before the 16th March. Those who cannot submit before will be able to do so on the morning of the competition. You cannot compete in the competition without your receipt.
3. The club will open at 5am on the morning.
4. Membership entry fee is R50 per person
5. Non-membership entry fee is R150 per person
6. Children under 10 are Free (no need for fishing licences if under age)
7. **NO TYING UP ON ANY JETTY WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE DAY, ANY ONE CAUGHT TYING UP WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
8. All prize winners must have valid fishing licenses unless you are younger than 10yrs old.
9. The entry fee is not repayable except in the event of the entry not being accepted by the organizers.
10. Every Skipper must be in possession of a competition receipt which shall be available at registration.
11. Every competitor must be in possession of a valid MCM angling license. Both the license and the receipt must be shown on request at registration, weigh-in and the prize giving.
12. Angling is only permitted from boats.
13. Only fish caught between 06:00 (Lines in) and 15h00 (scales close) on the day of the competition will qualify for prizes.
14. A minimum weight of 1 kilogram applies for weigh in
15. MARINE & COASTAL MANAGEMENT RULES MUST BE ADHERED TO
16. Fish may only be caught using conventional fishing rods.
17. There is no limit to the number of fishing rods which may be taken with nor is there a limit as to the line diameter which may be used.
18. Boats must have valid SAFETY CERTIFICATES and skippers to be in possession of a SKIPPERS CERTIFICATE.
19. Boats may only be launched from OPBC slipway.
20. Fish can be weighed in from 12h00 during the competition.
21. Scales close at 15h00. Closing time may change depending on conditions of the day.
22. Latecomers will be disqualified.
23. Anglers who disregard the rules or display unsporting behavior will be disqualified.
24. The decisions of the organizers are final.
25. The organizers are not responsible for any loss, damage or accidents which occur prior to, during and after the competition whether or not this is due to their negligence, The organizers undertake to do everything within their power to prevent such incidents and to ensure that the day is a success.
26. Should the competition be cancelled due to bad weather, the organizers will decide on a following date.
